

Annapolis consists of a Mayor, Recorder, six Aldermen  
and ten Common Council Men: The Mayor's Court  
holds plea of Actions of Debt not exceeding five pounds  
and of other small Trespasses & Misdemeanours.  
There is a Sheriff for the City of Annapolis and two  
or three Attorneys of the Mayor's Court whose fees are  
limited by Rule of Court, and are far less than what are  
taken in the County Courts —

The Court of Vice Admiralty was formerly  
held by Commissions under his late Royal Highness  
Prince George Lord High Admiral of England — who  
appointed a Judge Register and Martial, but since his  
Death that Court has not met, but is supposed may be  
again erected by particular Commissions from the  
Gov. and Vice Admiral of this Province for its purpose.

His Majesty has three Collectors of his Customs  
in this Province —

John Dawson Esq. for Putnam at 80 salary per An.  
James Bowles Esq. for Potomack at 60. per An.  
William Staughton Esq. for Accomack at 60. per An.  
Mr. W. Bladen is Surveyor of the Prov. at Annapolis at 60 per An.  
Mr. Tho. Collier is Survey. & Nav. Off. at Williamsstad at 60 per An.  
Mr. John Phelps is Survey. & Nav. Off. at Potomack at 60 per An.  
Mr. Stephen Knight is Survey. & Nav. Off. at Head of Bay at 60. per An.  
Mr. W. Forest is riding Survey. for the Seaboard side of Somerset County.

There are two receivers of his Matys Revenue within  
this Province, One, viz. John Rowby Esq. (who is Sur.  
Officer of Putnam) Receiver for that District as  
Salary of One hundred pounds per An. & to be paid  
him out of the King's Revenue fines & forfeitures.

And John Dawson Esq. is Receiver of his Matys Reve-  
nue in the District of Potomack at the <sup>same</sup> Salary of  
100 per An. —

The Proprietary has his Agent & Surveyor  
of Land Affairs —
