WHEREAS the General Assembly of this pro-
-vince now stands prorogued to the twentieth
day of February next ensuing, but for that His
most Sacred Majesty has been graciously
pleased to signify his Royal Will and
pleasure that the more immediate
Government of this Province should be
restored to the R^t Hon^{ble} Charles Lord Baron
of Baltimore and proprietor thereof
and that by reason of the Government
being to be so restored, it will not be
proper the said Assembly (not being called
by his Lordship's Writs of Election) should
again meet or proceed to enact Laws

Shave by and with the Advice of his
Majesty's Hon^{ble} Council thought fit
to give this my Proclamation to dissolve
the said General Assembly and do advise
