

Maryland &c. By His Excellency the Governour  
in A Proclamation

WHEREAS it is rumored, that many  
evil persons, in this Province, such as Papists,  
Nonjurors, & others, disaffected to the most la-  
ced person, & happy Governour, of our gracious  
overaigne King George, of Great Britain, &c. upon notice  
of the late insurrection & Rebellion, in Great  
Britain, adhering to the open & avowed enemies,  
of his Majesty's Crown, and the British Consti-  
tution, have industriously spread about divers  
malitious, false and untrue Reports leading to  
the discouraging, and breaking the Hearts of  
his Majesty's good & faithful Subjects, hereby  
advancing their false suggestions, of his Majesty's  
Troops being overpowered, by those of the Rebels  
in Great Britain, & by drinking the Health, &  
otherwise favouring the false & traitorous Claim, of  
a Popish Pretender against his Majesty's most  
lawfull & rightfull Title to the Kingdoms he  
so gloriously possesses, and auspiciously governs.

In order to restrain such unaccountable,  
traitorous, & disloyal Actions, & obviate the  
Malice and evil practices, of such disaffected evil  
minded persons, in this Province, I have thought  
fit, by and with the advice of his Lordship's Hon<sup>ble</sup>  
Council of State, to make this my Proclamation,  
in the name of the R<sup>ts</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Pro-  
prietarie, of this Province, strictly charging
