

within the same especially, at the presence,  
carefully, look for the dimensions, of such persons  
in their respective Counties, and upon any notice  
or suspicion, they shall have any such traitor,  
disloyal, or other unwarrantable proceedings,  
of any such Papists, Nonjurors, or other suspected  
persons, forthwith to cause them to be apprehen-  
ded, & brought before their Magistrates, who are  
to tender unto them, the Oath, appointed by  
Act of Parliament, instead of the Oath, of Allegi-  
ance & Supremacy, also the Oath appointed by  
the Act, of the fifth & sixth years, of the late  
Queen, intituled an Act, for the further security  
of her Majesty's Person & Government, and of the suc-  
cession to the Crown of Great Britain, in the Pro-  
testant Line, which they are to require them,  
to take, and also subscribe, the last mentioned  
Oath, for the security of the Succession together  
with the Declaration, appointed by the Act of  
Parliament, made in the 25. Year of King Charles  
the second, commonly called the Test, ~~and~~ refusal  
to take, or the J. Magistrates, are hereby commanded  
& enjoyned, to oblige them, to find and give good  
Security, for their Behaviour, & Appearance at  
next County Court, on default whereof they are  
to commit them to the County Gaol, till such Secu-  
rity be given, or they shall otherwise be delivered  
by due course of Law, <sup>whenever the Magistrates are empowered to</sup> and that all  
persons whatsoever residing or being within  
this Province, may have just & sufficient Notice
