the several and respective sheriffs, of the sever<sup>al</sup>  
and respective counties, duly to publish the same,  
at all Churches, Parishes, and Court houses,  
within their several districts, and at all such  
and other most publick, & frequented places  
to make & affix sundry copies thereof, attested  
by them. Whereof let them not fail at their  
peril. Given at the City of Annapolis, this  
14. day of Febr<sup>r</sup>uary, in the first year of the Re-  
ign, of their R<sup>d</sup> Hon<sup>b</sup> Charles Lord Baro<sup>r</sup>  
of Baltimore, aforesaid Lord & Proprietarie  
of the Province of Maryland &c value, &c  
Anno<sup>r</sup> D<sup>r</sup> 1715. —

Ordered that the respective sheriffs  
of the sever<sup>al</sup> County<sup>s</sup>, in this Province, take an  
account of the names, of all Papists or  
Roman Catholiques, in their sever<sup>al</sup> County<sup>s</sup>, &  
return the same, on a fair list with an exact  
number of those people, residing in their  
respective County<sup>s</sup>. —
