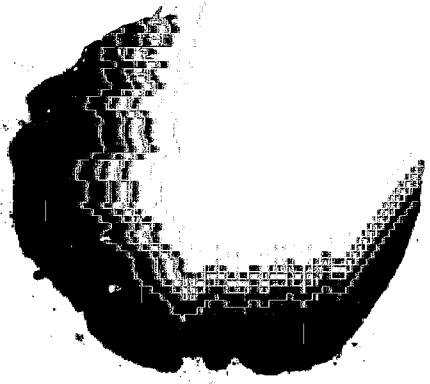


whereby the Force of this Proclamation, may be

to make & affix sundry Copies thereof, attested
by them. Hereof let them not fail on their
perills. Given at the City of Annapolis, this
14. day of Febr.^y in the first year of the Re-
minder, of the R^{oy}. Hon^{ble}. Charles, Lord Baron
of Baltimore, absolute Lord & Proprietarie
of the Province, of Maryland & Avalon, &c.
witnessed the 17. 1715. —

Ordered that the respective Sheriffs,
of the sever.^{all} Counties, in this Province, take an
Account of the Names, of all Papists or
Roman Catholics, in their sever.^{all} Counties, &
returne the same on a fair List with an exact
Number of those people, residing in their
respective Counties. —
