The honorable Col<sup>o</sup> Thomas Smith being  
appointed one of his Lordships Council  
took the Oath to his Majesty, appointed  
instead of the Oath of Allegiance and Supre-  
-macy, as also the Oath of Abjuration, which  
he subscribed, as likewise the Declaration  
commonly called the Test. And then took  
the Oath as one of his Lordships Council. After  
which he took his place at the Board.

His Excellency layd before the  
Board the Copy of the Charter for the two Shires  
and the sentence of the Lord in from his self  
and his Guardian.

Which was read to them for their Consideration.

He also signifies his Lordships plea  
of accepting the sentence of the Lord.
