put off and prorogue the sitting of said
Assembly until the twenty fourth day of this
instant April and the same We hereby pro-
rogue accordingly, whereof you and every
of you are to take due Notice, and no wayes
to fail meeting at this place on the said
twenty fourth day of April aforesaid.

1716 in the first Year of Our Dominion
