in this Province and also to pay off all demands  
towards his Majesty and his said King's Government in this  
Province or elsewhere & putt them to the County Goal  
there to remain till sufficient legal proceedings may  
be had against them as their demerits shall require  
And to the end that all persons may have due notice  
hereof and none pretend Ignorance by doing in this  
Land what is thereby expressly named (punished) and required  
the respective Sheriff of the several Counties in  
this Province to publish this my proclamation at  
all Churches & Chappells of dars and other the most  
frequented places in their said Counties whereof they  
are not to fail at their posts given at the City of  
Bunyopolis under the Great Seal of the Province  
this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January in the second year of His  
Lordship Dominick & Simon 1716

Given  
His Excellency Sir John on this board the second  
Master of His Majestys Comptain that the post Charged  
them by the Deputy Collector of the port of Bunyopolis -  
for Clearing their Vessels were unreasonable -

Whereupon Ordered that some of the Masters who  
are now in the town be sent for to inform this board what  
fees they have usually paid on the Clearing their Ships -  
which being accordingly done appears by  
George Westgarth who being asked what he generally  
paid on Clearing his ship to the Collector for the port
