...you have presented to the Assembly that
we think it convenient and necessary that the
Duty of three pence of Tax upon the Burthen of
Tolls and Wapentakes Trading into the Province,
which by Act of Assembly has been formerly paid
into the Exchequer for the Time being, be continued
& applied to the better Support and Dignity
of such person of our Council, who we intend
with the Administration of the Government
during the Absence, or on the Death or Removal
of our Lieutenant Governor for the Time being,
of our said Province.

You shall either by Proclamation or
otherwise prorogue the Assembly to some day
in the Month of April which shall be in the
Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred &
Twenty.

7. And Lastly we Stricly Charge Command &
Require you the said John Hart and all other
our Officers and Ministers within our Province
of Maryland to be Assisting to his Majestys Officers
of the Customs, as by Law you are Required to do,
And not in the least to obstruct his Majestys Service
or Management of the Officers of the Customs as by
their Letter a Copy whereof we have here with us
is Complaind of -
