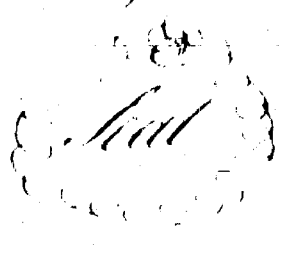


Sheweth the chief Deputy from the Seneguan King

Sir William Keith Baronet Gov^t
of the Province of Pennsylvania & Counties
of Newcastle Kent and Sussex upon Delaware

Wth to whom these presents shall come your
know ye that Sheweth the Barons hereof with diverse other
Indians of his Majesty's Province sent by the Kings or
day of the said States to renew Treaties of Friendship
with the several others of his Majesty's Government on the
River Susquehanna and Bay of Chesapeake and having
held such a treaty with them are now proceeding to the Gov^t
of Maryland and Virginia to hold the like Treaties with
them respectively more effectually to establish peace and
Friendship between their People of the said five Nations
and his Majesty's Subjects of the said Governments

I do therefore hereby require all his Majesty's
Subjects of this Province and request and desire all others
of the said Neighbouring Governments that they kindly
assist and that the said Indians and favour them in
their said intended journey they returning themselves rea-
sonably and as cometh Given under my hand and Seal
at Lancaster the 9th day of July in the 7th Year of the Reign of
our Sovereign Lord King George King of Great Britain &c
during Pennam 1724
