Annalogue further gives a history of the Saguenay  
and陈述 that as we have all kinds of fury, force  
or affliction we should be against them as we must  
all follow another of it and suffer as well but not  
to go far out to make war against our enemies the first  
by being a alliance wholly defensive.

The Governor presents to Annalogue two broad  
Medals that everyone for himself and the other  
so distinguished a great man of the said Province in  
Praise of their Bell of Peace and in token that we are  
all friends having presented the Seigneur yesterday

The Seigneur likewise told the Governor they had by  
themselves sending them by water to Saguenay and  
that if any just rebuke should happen to them they should  
not lay it at the Governor's door but take it upon them  
selves.

On pasturage with the Indians Interpreter they  
say they did not tell us that the Indians had kill'd their  
friends to Saguenay that we mistook them for  
that they say those Indians live towards the sun setting  
from the mountain and down River from Saguenay and  
that the Saguenay Indians and they were often a fighting
