


In his opinion his Lord, I doth much you excepted towards

upon him there finding this depositment further added that being
reflected upon and abased by the builder of that house &
knowing that if he stand to keep his pension there he could
make no Crop and must necessarily be quit sufficient
his plantation upon this where he withdrew the same

And this depositment further added when he went from
his service upon the Island of St. Croix aforementioned called Queen
Charlotte's that he walked up the side of the said house before
and knockt up the door of the dwelling House which could
not be opened without great force and that when he returned
the next time to his said plantation he found the dwelling
house door open and a keyless shop made of his brick house
