next give me the City of Annapolis under his Lordships  
the Right Honble the Lord Proprietors Counter Seal at  
Anne the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October in the 8<sup>th</sup> year of the reign  
of our sovereign Lord King George and in the 6<sup>th</sup>  
year of his reign anno Domini 1721
