I am honoured with yours dated this day by
 Mr. Sayer the great Seneca Indian by the best account
 I can have was killed at M^onewasay about ten days
 past by John Caldwell ^{of Conestogoe} who was then in company with
 his Brother Edmund Caldwell the way he murdered
 him was by making a violent stroke at his head with
 the Indian Iron Gun and drove the head of the Cock
 into his brains, the reasons of this Fact were, because the
 said Indian could not buy of the Iron which they brought
 there to sell, the informers are John James Bradman Junior
 and some Indians who came were afterwards to the Sugar
 Lands the two Caldwells were undoubtedly returned to Co
 nestogoe where they have their Families and very good
 Settlements, soon after the Indian was slain they packed
 up their Goods and travelled homewards I am since
