Province and to be published by them in the most publick
manner and

That the writs of Prohibition directed to the High
Sheriff of Annapolis County to read publicly to mor-
row in the Council Chamber in the presence of his Excellency
and such members of the upper and Lower houses as shall
then be in Town

To all which Resolutions his Excellency concurs

His Excellency having communicated a perusal
of a Letter from Col Alexander Spotswood Governor of Vir-
ginia signifying his intended Journey to Albany in order
to meet the Indians then in company with Sir William
Keith Governor of Pennsylvania to adjust all differences
between them and to settle a lasting peace with said In-
dians and desiring to know whether his Excellency would
meet him there to those purposes and having desired the
Opinion of this Board thereon

In answer this Board say they are of Opinion that
having so lately renewed our former Treaties with the
said Indians and being in perfect peace and amity
