

stall<sup>s</sup> In Testimony whereof we have made this our present  
Will<sup>r</sup> in our trusty and well Belovet Charles Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup>  
our Captain General and Governor in chief of our said  
Province and Colony of Maryland this 3 day of July  
in the sev<sup>th</sup> year of our dominion & anno Domini
