His Excellency the Governor having acquainted the
Board with several Infringements of the Pennsylvania
and particularly that Isaac Taylor and Elizab. Churchill
had run out several Sines in this Province and threatened
several persons as appears by the proceedings of last Council
to deprive them of their Plantation if they refused to submit to
the Pennsylvania Government and likewise that very
lately taken up W. Kirribber the chief Justice of Cecil
County laid for no other Offence real or pretended than
for running out some Sines in the wild forest up and
down the Branches of Aquaruminechick wonder to dis-
cover the true location of Saint Augustines Mannors West
from limits and asking the opinion and advice of the Board
whereon it is the opinion and advice of the Board that
Proclamation be made to warn the Inhabitants of Cecil County
and others concerned of the Infringements and Encroachments
aforesaid and that all persons concerned take notice thereof
at their peril
