

of the Land in difference between the Proprietors of Ma-  
 :ryland and Pennsylvania and those disputable Lands lying  
 all of them towards the Bay of Delaware and the Eastern  
 Sea but that all the other Lands towards Chesapeake Bay  
 and the Susquehanna together with all the Remaining  
 Lands was above by order of Council unto the 1<sup>st</sup> degree  
 of North Latitude divided from the Land commonly  
 called Delaware positively and in express terms  
 declared to be the Right of the Lord Baltimore and on the  
 same order was judged to be comprised within his Charter  
 and consequently no part of that exception which was  
 taken to the Charter of Maryland upon a pretence that  
 certain Lands upon the Delaware were inhabited and plan-  
 ted by Christians at and before the date of the Grant thereof  
 all which will plainly appear to persons of the meanest  
 Capacity after having duly considered the Letter and  
 design of the within order of Council tho made altogether  
 in favour of the Proprietors of Pennsylvania of which all  
 persons are to take notice at their pleasure to the end  
 that his Lordships proclamation should be made pub-  
 :lick the Sheriff of Cecil County is hereby Commanded to  
 publish the same in the usual and most noted manner  
 Given at the City of Annapolis this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January  
 in the eighth year of the dominion of the right honorable  
 Charles Collins Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces  
 of Maryland and Avalon &c Anno Domini 1722
