Opinion that it is proper to prorogue the Assembly to some
further time and that Tuesday the 2^d day of July is a conve-
nient time to prorogue the same to that being a Season free
from Courts and other publick Business

Thereupon Order'd that Proclamations sh^d be issued to prorogue
the present General Assembly to Tuesday the 2^d day of
July next
