 have due notice thereof I do strictly require and Com-  
 mand the several Sheriffs of this Province to make this  
 my proclamation publick in the usual manner as  
 they will answer the contrary at their peril Given at  
 Annapolis this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March in the 8<sup>th</sup> Year of the  
 dominion of the right honorable Charles Absolute Lord  
 and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland & Avalon
