their promise made to Mr Carew as aforesaid

On the other hand in the year 1718 some persons
tho' of Rank in Maryland yet being led entirely by Gain
without any regard to Justice or the publick peace did
take upon them actually to make Surveys of very con-
siderable Tracts of Land as high as most as Comstocke in
the Province of Pennsylvania and above thirty miles
North of all former Claims of Maryland of which Com-
plaint having been made to Col John Hart then Governour
of Maryland and his Excellency having likewise Com-
plaint of some Regulations which had been made amongst
the Pennsylvanians at Nottingham by William Keith
Esq Governour of that Province an interview was appointed
between both the Governours at Col Wynsons House upon the
Eastern Shore in Maryland where they met accordingly on
wards the latter end of October and the Minute of that Con-
ference taken by Consent of both Parties is as follows

A Meeting between the Governours of Mary-
land and Pennsylvania held at Col Wynsons
House the 28th day of October 1718
