

with your Request thereto let my Lord Baltimore & a just Estimate of his Excellency's conduct and diligent Care in the Government under his direction Mr. Heath having requested that his Excellency will be pleased to communicate to him the proposed measures proposed and either by Proclamation from England or by his Excellency and Mr. Heath are sufficiently enabled and advised to proceed otherwise.

His Excellency concurring very much to wait upon Mr. Heath recalling those Commissions at Höttingham Governor Heath begged to be excused from giving any other answer at this time until he had an opportunity to advise with his Council so the matter might present itself to the further consideration of the respective Governors and the Councils of both provinces.

Upon reading the paper above mentioned the Board observed that the Compiler of the said paper had great Steps upon the Interest and Knowledge of those Gentlemen Magistrates and others of the Northern parts of Maryland who were then said to have waited upon Mr. Penn in the year 1700 as he was travelling from below Annapolis to west the Indian Conestoga and being informed that the honble John Hall Esq a member of this Board was one of those Gentlemen who met Mr. Penn and waited upon him and suggested such things gave directions that a number of Council should be directed to the chief Justice and the rest of the Justices in Baltimore County to take the deposition of the said John Hall Esq relating to those matters in Pursuance whereof the
