 Plantation he had newly procured from England which Ob-

 as is there said and found very defective which he offered to
 prove by a Letter under his hand to the said Mr. Carol &
 it being also said that during these disputes several Letters
 passed between Mr. Penn's Commissioners of Property & Mr.
