And whereas we have informed you to let and lease
for three lives or one and twenty years our Mannors on the
the Eastern Shore (namely) only excepted and we having
Reason to believe that Application will be made to you for
a Lease or Leases of some part or parts of our Mannors of Sus-
quehanna formerly forfeited to my Grandfather by Col.
George Talbot you are required before you make any Lease
or Leases of any part thereof to Consult Mr Philemon Lloyd
and if his Objections are removed concerning which my
Secretary Mr Lowe has wrote to him you may then lease
out any part or parts thereof on the usual Conditions as
is directed by my 7th Instruction but you shall except out
of such Leases all Mines of Gold Silver Copper and Tin
to me my heirs and Successors
