Whereas this present General Assembly stands
prorogued to Sunday the Second day of July next
and whereas there are no Affairs of moment to be laid be-
fore them which require their attendance at that Time
I have thought fit with the advice of his Lordships
Council of State further to prorogue and I do hereby
further prorogue the same to Monday the 23^d day of
September next and to the Intent that all persons Con-
cerned may have due Notice thereof. I strictly require
and charge the several Sheriffs of this Province to pub-
lish this my Proclamation in the usual manner as
they will answer the contrary at their perill Given
at Annapolis this 10th day of May in the 8th Year of the
Dominion of the right Honble Charles Absolute Lord
and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and
Avalon &c^o Annoq^o Domini 1723
