the 23^d day of the same month and whereas there is no

that time I have therefore thought fit with the advice
of his Lordships Council of State further to prorogue
the same and I do hereby further Prorogue the same
to the third Tuesday in June next being the 15th day of
the same month and to the Intent that all persons con-
:cerned may have due Notice thereof I do strictly Charge &
Command the several Sheriffs of this Province to make
this my Proclamation publick in their respective Coun-
:ties in the usual manner as they will answer the Con-
:trary at their perill Given at Annapolis this 25th day of
February in the tenth Year of the Dominion of the right
