

To invite some of the Pincayal Indians of the
same Town to meet his Excellency the Governor at
the house of Charles Anderson near Mononkawea at
such time as shall be mentioned in his Excellency's
instructions to the said Powell which Instructions follow
hereunder. Instructions for Mr. John Powell as
followeth viz.

I instruct you John Powell by the Government
of the Governor and Council of this Province are to take
to your assistance a proper Interpreter and Guide
and any other person for your convenience if you
think fit and convenient to the Indian known of them
commonly called Pincayal so far as conveniently
you can and there to acquaint the Pincayal
Indians of the said Anderson behalf of the said
Baltimore and Charles (alike) present Governor
of this Province to acknowledge the three skins recei-
ved by them in return of another present sent to them
from our Governor by Charles Anderson and inform them
of the expectation we have had of seeing them at Anna-
polis according to the information we had of the said
Charles Anderson but forasmuch as we apprehend
other from the length of the way or the Unseasonable-
ness of the weather they have not been able to come
downe we for their better convenience and to shew
our Friend & Friendship for them and with desire
to live with them as Friends and Brethren I do
Propose a meeting between our Governor and some of
the Council with their chie and some of their great
men at the house of Charles Anderson the fifth of
