they had been adjudged by the Courts

It is presumed therefore to advise your Honour
that in our humble Opinion the use of flowers not
supported by Law is the only means whereby some peo-
ple may have a handle for censuring your Honours
Proceedings with Impunity and therefore hope
your Honour will concur with us in believing that
the use of flowers in the present case are altogether
unnecessary and Inconvenient
