His Excellency the Governor acquaints the Board of his Intention of meeting the Shawano Indians near mouth pursuant to a Message lately sent to them from this Board by Mr^r Powell to settle Articles of Peace with them whereupon it is advised that the Articles already entered into with the Conestogo Indians & are proper Articles to be concluded and agreed to with the said Shawano Indians and it further thought necessary by this Board that his Excellency upon making such Treaty with them present them with one Dozen Callico Shirts and Shifes Six Watch Coats and as much powder and Shot as his Excellency shall find to be proper and to make a reasonable Bargain with the said Indians for bringing down those Negroes already amongst them now shall hereafter turn to them as his Excellency at his discretion shall think fit

And it is further the Opinion of this Board that what ever Negroes shall be brought down by the said Shawano Indians be and remain in Custody until the sense of the Assembly of this Province be known in Relation thereto

His Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r Qualifies himself at this Board as Chancellor of Maryland and Keeper of the Great Seal thereof by taking the several
