And Excellency deliver to this Board an answer from the Gov^r and Council of Virginia to their Letter lately sent to them which answer is as follows

Gentlemen

Williamsburgh May 27th 1726

It was with much satisfaction that we received yesterday the Honor of your letter of the 21st Instant which brought us the equally pleasant account of the disposition of your Province to
