Licence which the Beavers License is made is his Land
and therefore will not suffer the Indians to hunt there for
Beaver the Rent of their Lands is to be paid in Beaver
skins

2^d That they are threatened & pursued to hunt in the
Hickcullat, Huron, Mack and Cedar neck William Lyster
in Ricey Neck, John Collins in Cedar Neck and Thomas
Robinson in Cedar Neck threatening to beat them and break
their Guns and break their Guns to make the Indians more
afraid beat one of the young men with a Huron Stick
about two years ago

Indian Story of the same Nation complains that
the last Summer a little before berry time he was met in
Dowd County by one John Howard who had several
times threatened that if he met him in those
woods & hunting that he would beat him and break his
Guns but at the time aforesaid finding he had three Guns
Robinson had such he said him with hunting in his
woods notwithstanding his warning and then seized
his Gun and broke it broke his head knocked him down
with it and left him for dead and that he lay ill of the
wound 3 days at Suncet Woods where he got with
the assistance of his wife who was in the woods with him

Ordered that the Clerk of this Board make out Summons
Directed to the Sheriff of Somerset and Dowd County for
the Pleas as before mentioned and also for Philimon Selcompte
and Isaac Nichols that they be and appear at the City of
Charleston at the next Session of Assembly that shall hap-
pen after the date hereof to answer the Complaint Exhibited
