

That the English stand and I give them of hunting
Power and that I will tell the Indians that the
Section in which the Beaver dam is made is his land
and therefore will not suffer the Indians to hunt there for
Beaver in the time of their hunt is to be paid in Beaver
Horn.

That they are authorized to hunt in the
Hickory Stick and Cedar neck William Pepper
in Hickory Stick John Collins and Godwin and Thomas
Robinson in cedar neck threatening to beat them and break
their guns and Caesar Godwin to make the Indians run
afraid before one of the young men with a Hickory Stick
about two years ago

Indian King of the same Nation complains that
the last summer a little before harvest time he was met in
Overset Woods by one John Howard who had several
times threatened him and said that if he met him in those
woods a hunting that he would beat him and break his
Gun but at the same instant fearing he had three gun
shins on his back he laid hand with hunting in his
woods notwithstanding his threatening and there seized
his Gun and broke his head knocked him down
with it and left him for dead and that he lay all of the
wood 3 days at Succotawoods where he got with
the assistance of his wife who was in the woods with him

Ordered that the Clerk of this Board make out summons
directed to the Sheriff of Somerset and Dorset Countys for
the Plaintiff before mentioned and also for Philémon LeCompte
and Isaac Sticks that they be and appear at the City of
Bridgwater the next Session of Assembly that shall hap-
pen after the date hereof to witness the complaint exhibited
