His Excellency the Governor in Council who had the  
 keeping of the Seal and desired the same may be brought  
 to this Board which was accordingly presented to his Excellency  
 by John Beale Esq; to whose Custody the same was  
 committed by the Honourable Charles Calvert Esq; then Chan-  
 cellor and thereupon his Excellency the Governor took  
 the Oath of Chancellor and delivered the said Seal to the  
 said John Beale to be by him kept as usual until his  
 Excellency's Pleasure should be further known therein

Which Oath of Chancellor was as follows

I Benedict Leonard Calvert do swear that as  
 Chancellor and Keeper of the Great Seal of this Province  
 I will well and truly serve the right Honourable the  
 Lord Proprietary of this Province and do equal right  
 to all his Majestys subjects to the best of my Understan-  
 ding. And I do knowe by my knowledge I will not do any hinder  
 the Execution of Justice nor take any Grafts Bribes
