some County in the Colony and Dominion of Virginia afores-  
to the end that they may be brought before some Justice of  
the Peace of such County to be dealt with according to Law  
Given under my hand and the seal of the Colony aforesaid  
this twenty fourth day of June in the thirteenth Year of  
the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George
