His Majesty being this day present in Council
was pleased to make the following Declaration viz

The sudden and unexpected death of the King my
dearest Father has filled my heart with so much con-
cern and sorrow that I am at a loss how to express
myself upon this great and melancholy Occasion

I am sensible of the weight that immediately
falls upon me by taking the Government of a Nation
so powerful at Home and of such Influence and Conse-
quence abroad but my Love and Affection to this Country
from my Knowledge and Experience of you makes
me not uncheerfully to undergo all difficulties for
the sake and good of my People
