GIVEN at the Court at Leicester House this fourteenth
day of June 1727

(God save the King)

London June 16th

Yesterdays about noon his present Majesty George
the second was proclaimed King of Great Britain France
and Ireland at Leicester House having Cwss. Temple
F. Baill Cheynd and the Royal Exchangers with the usual
solemnities the former Minister of State and a great
Number of the Nobility and Gentry attending on the
Occasion with the Kings Heralds and Pursuivants at
arms in their proper Habits succeeded by a Detachment
of Horse and Foot Guards when they came to
Temple Bar the gates being shut were upon Knocking
at them called to be opened by the right Honourable
the Lord Mayor accompanied by the Aldermen and
Sheriffs in their robes and at night there were Bon-
fires Illuminations and other rejoicings throughout
this City and Suburbs

His Majesty King George the second's
most gracious Declaration at his first sitting in
the Privy Council at the Court Leicester House
the 1st day of June 1727

dearst Father has filled my heart with so much con-
cern and surprise that I am at a loss how to express
