Ordered that Edmund Protestantem Esq. to the several Counties directed to the third and fourth persons in Commission in the respective Counties to swear the Chief Justice and that he swear all other Officers both Civil and military that shall apply to take the Oaths in the several Counties

Ordered that the Clerk of this Board write to the several Sheriffs of this Province to give notice to the several Members in their respective Counties that they are to meet at Annapolis the 2 Tuesday in October next in Order to proceed on Business
