

Which Proclamation I find accordingly
 It having been observed by this Board that the
 Seal of the Provinciall Court as well as most of the seals
 of the several County Courts have his Majesty's Royal
 Arms thereon

Resolved that the bearing of his Majesty's Royal Arms
 to any Process or Warrant issuing out of his Lordship's Courts
 in his Lordship's Name in this Province is altogether Im-
 proper and Inconvenient

Thereupon it is Ordered that the several Justices
 of the said Courts take due care as soon as conveniently
 may be to provide a new Seal with his Lordship's Arms
 and the Title of each Court circumscribed thereon and
 that the Clerk of this Board transmit a Copy of this
 Order to the several Justices of the said Courts

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore
 send to England by the first Opportunity for one hundred
 and twenty Quills of Gunpowder for the use
 of the publick and in case there shall be Books of Horse and
 Foot Exercise formerly sent for by him that the said
 Treasurer send for one hundred of them by the same
 Opportunity and that the Clerk serve the said Treasurer
 with this Order

Whereas this Board hath been informed that some
 Masters of Ships have lately pretended to refuse the Pay-
 ment of the Porten per cent of Tonnage to his Lordship
 Ordered that the several Naval Officers take due Care
 that his Lordship's said duty be punctually paid as usual
