The before mentioned Edward Harris appears at this Board pursuant to a Recognizance entered into before the said Justices & ordered that the said Harris be Discharged therefrom

Several Accounts being Laid before this board for work done to the Council Room Ordered that Charles Calvert and Benj. Tasher Esqrs Inspect & Settle the Same with the Several Persons in order to be allowed at the next Council.
