

The Proclamation being prepared pursuant to an Order of this Board of the 13th Instant was read, and approved of, and ordered to issue accordingly, The Tenor of which is as follows

A Proclamation

Whereas I have received His Most Sacred Majesty's Instructions bearing Date at the Court of Richmond the 18th Day of June 1728 in the second Year of his Reign thereby declaring his Royal Will and Pleasure that in all the Prayers Litanies and Collects for the Royal Family instead of the Words [His Royal Highness George Prince of Wales the Prince and their Issue and all the Royal Family] there should be inserted [Our Gracious Queen Caroline the Royal Issue and the Rest of the Royal Family] with His Royal Command That his said Will and Pleasure be forthwith published in the several Parish Churches and other Places of Divine Worship within this Province that Obedience be paid thereto accordingly I do therefore by and with the Advice of His Lordships Honourable Council publish this my Proclamation notifying the same to all his Majesty's Good Subjects that in the several Parish Churches and other Places of Divine Worship within this Province in all the Prayers Litanies and Collects for the Royal Family instead of the Words [His Royal Highness George Prince of Wales the Prince and their Issue and all the Royal Family] be for the future used and inserted [Our Gracious Queen Caroline the Royal Issue and the rest of the Royal Family] and I do strictly charge and command the several Rectors of this Province to make this my Proclamation publick in the several Churches within their said Counties in the usual manner that the most publick Notice may be had thereof as they will answer the contrary at their Peril Given at Annapolis this Eighteenth Day of February in the fourteenth Year of His Lordships the Proprietarys Dominion of Maryland 1728
