Tilghman draw upon the publick Treasurers or either of them for the money that he  
shall agree for, for the said Arms, and the said Treasurers or either of them are hereby  
required to pay the same upon the said Col<sup>d</sup> Tilghman's Order out of the Money due from  
them for Arms

On the back of which was the following Endorsement

Pay unto Richard Bennett Esq. and Com<sup>rs</sup> the sum of One hundred eighty seven  
pounds thirteen Shillings and six Pence Sterling Money on Acco. of the within Order

And the said Col<sup>d</sup> Tilghman says that the Arms were bought and delivered at Anna:  
polis for which the above Order was drawn, and as M<sup>r</sup> Bennett has returned him the  
Order, and (as he believes) never received the money, nor M<sup>r</sup> Ungle (as he can find)  
charged the Publick therewith, he humbly leaves it to the consideration of this board  
what may be proper to be done therein

This Board are of Opinion in Relation thereto that the properest thing to be  
done at present, is, that M<sup>r</sup> Chamberlain search among the Papers of the late M<sup>r</sup>  
Ungle, if the said Order is any way charged among his Acc<sup>ts</sup>, and make Oath of  
his having so done, to be produced at the next meeting of this Honble Board.

M<sup>r</sup> Rachel Denton Clerk of the Provincial Court produces to this Board the Journ<sup>ls</sup>  
of Accounts for several Years; upon Inspection whereof it was found that many  
were wanting, whereupon the said M<sup>r</sup> Denton says, it was with Difficulty  
he found these, they being upon loose Papers, but will endeavour, if possible,  
to find the rest.
