His Excellency the Governor produces to this Board Instructions from the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in Relation to the Difents to Some Laws and afterwards the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietaries Separate Difent to Each Particular Law which Instructions and Difents are as follow

Instructions

Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c Orders and Instructions Powers and Authoritys to be Observed and Pursued by Our Dearly Beloved Brother the Hon^{ble} Benedict Leonard Calvert Esq: Our Lieutenant Governor of Our Province of Maryland.

You will herewith receive my Difents to the following Acts of Assembly to be Published and Enter'd on Record according to Your Forms Viz

Whereas at a Sessions of Assembly begun and held in Our Province of Maryland the Third Day of October and ending the Second Day of November in the Fourteenth Year of Our Dominion over the said Province Annoq³ Domini 1728. These Acts passed An Act for Ascertaining the Form of the Oath of Judge or Justice. Also an Act for Improving the Staple of Tobacco. And a Supplementary Act to the Act Intituled an Act for the Establishm^t of Religious Worship in this Province according to the Church of England and for the maintenance of Ministers

Also Whereas at a Sessions of Assembly begun and held in Our said Province of Maryland the tenth Day of July and ending the eighth Day of August in the Fifteenth Year of Our Dominion Over the said Province Annoq³ Domini 1729. An Act concerning the Parishes in S^t. Marys and Charles Counties Also an Act reviving and continuing an Act to restrain the ill Practices of Attorneys and to prevent their taking Money Fees, and Ascertaining what Fees shall be allowed to the Practitioners in the Law who shall attend the Circuit Courts.

We on due Consideration had and taken of the said Acts - have thought fit to Difent unto them and do hereby declare the aforesaid Acts to be Null Void and of no Effect.
