A Proclamation

Whereas his most sacred Majesty by Letter under His Royal Sign Manual and by the Letters of His Grace the Duke of Newcastle One of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State hath graciously been pleased to signify unto me the Treaty concluded at Seville on the ninth Day of November N. S. 1729 between His Majesty and the most Christian King of the One Part, and the King of Spain of the Other; with His Royal Commands for the cessation of Hostilities and Restitution of Prizes to the Subjects of Spain in America; and also the King of Spain'sedula for the cessation of Hostilities and the like Restitution of Prizes on the Part of his Subjects; and His Majesty having further commanded me to make known to all and singular the Officers and Ministers of this Province, and all Others whom it may concern his Royal Pleasure and Intention thereupon: I have thought fit by and with the Advice of His Lordships Council of State to publish and make known by this my Proclamation, that it is the Will and Pleasure of his most sacred Majesty that all and singular his Subjects do forbear and abstain from all Acts of Hostility against the Subjects of the King of Spain, and that if any Prize or Prizes have been or shall be taken from his Subjects since the 22 Day of June 1728 full Restitution be made of such Prize or Prizes, or in Default thereof of the just Value of the said Prizes and their
