A Proclamation

Whereas Charles Abbot Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland
and Ceciliæ Lord Baron of Baltimore by his Commission under his Great Seal at
Anne Arundel Court at Annapolis the twentieth Day of June have with the Approba-
tion of His Most Sacred Majesty been pleased to constitute me the said Samuel Ugle
Governor and Commander in Chief in and over this His Lordships Province of Mary-
land, which said Commission was published this Day, and read in the Presence
of the Lord and bearing of many the Kings Subjects his Lordships Tenants in this Province at the
City of Annapolis have therefore thought fit to issue this my Proclamation notifying
in the same to all the other Magistrates and others his Lordships Officers in this
Province; and further will and direct that all Officers both Civil & Military
execute and discharge the several Trusts and Duties in them imposed and enjoyed
by the present respective Commissions to them granted until such time as my further
Mandate and Directions shall be signified therin Given at the City of Annapolis
this Eleventh Day of July in the seventh Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord
George the second and in the nineteen Year of His Lordships Dominion of Maryland
