A Proclamation

Whereas Charles Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Nealon Lord Baron of Baltimore by his Commission under his Great Seal at Rome bearing Date at Annapolis the twentieth Day of June last with the Approbation of His Most Sacred Majesty been pleased to constitute me the said Samuel Ogle Governor and Commander in Chief in and over this His Lordships Province of Maryland which said Commission was published this Day, and read in the Presence and hearing of many the Kings Subjects his Lordships Tenants in this Province at the City of Annapolis I have therefore thought fit to issue this my Proclamation notifying the same to all the Sheriffs Magistrates and Officers his Lordships Officers in this Province, and I do further will and direct that all Officers both Civil and Military execute and discharge the several Trusts and Duties in them proposed and enjoyned by the present respective Commissions to them granted until such time as my further Pleasure and Directions shall be signified therein Given at the City of Annapolis this Eleventh Day of July in the seventh Year of the Reigne of Our Sovereign Lord George the second and in the nineteenth Year of His Lordships Dominion of Annapolis
