Whereas It appears to us the Subscribers Members of his Lordship's honourable Council met in Council at the City of Annapolis the 21. of February 1733, that Joshua Minshul hath fomented divers Riots and Disturbances, and frequently disparaged the Title of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland to the said Province, and hath given out in threatening and menacing Speeches that he would shoot his Lordship or any Person who should dare to act by Virtue of any Authority derived from his Lordship against the Peace
