It is the Opinion of this Board that his Execution be at present suspended,  
and referred to further Consideration, until such time as the Attorney  
General may have thoroughly perused and considered the Judgment  
and other Procefs against him as by this Board he is desired to do  
and make Report thereof with all convenient speed.

This Excellency having this Day communicated to  
and laid before this Board his Majesty's late Order in Council  
dated the 25th Day of May last past for carrying into Execution  
a late temporary Agreement between the Right Honourable  
the Lord Proprietary of this Province and the Proprietors of  
Pennsylvania, as also several Letters from the Governor of  
Pennsylvania, together with a Copy of the Agreement from the  
Lord Proprietary this Day received by his Excellency inclosed  
in a Letter to him from William Jansen Esq. his Lordships  
Secretary which Agreement is as follows
