

The Vestry of the said Parish have represented to me that there is not any Minister in the said Parish, and have also presented to me You the said Ralph Elstone as a sober and discreet Person to be a Reader in the said Parish Therefore for the performing the Duty and Office of a Reader in the said Parish in reading Divine Service Homilies and such other Good Authors of Practical Divinity as shall be appointed in the Church or Chappel of the said Parish, and not in any other Manner (having first taken the Oath subscribing the Test and Abjuration) and also demeaning your self according to the Liturgy of the Church of England I do by these presents grant License and Faculty to you the said Ralph Elstone to be such Reader to continue during Pleasure providing such Continuance to have take and receive from the Vestry of the said Parish One half of the forty pounds of Tobacco of Poll growing due from the Inhabitants of the said Parish In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 27th Day of November in the twenty fourth Year of his Lordships Dominion Annoq Domini 1738.
