These are therefore in his Lordships Name to will and require you that immediately on Receipt here of you attach arrest and apprehend the Body of him the said Robert Connant and bring him forth with befalls at the City aforesaid to answer unto such Matters as shall be then and there objected against him, for which this shall be your sufficient Warrant Dated at Annapolis this 6th Day of May Anno Domini 1740
